### DETAIL ITINERARY.

**Dt. 28/5/2024 WELCOME TO HARIDWAR.**

- Pick up from Delhi railway station.
- Start drive for haridwar and check on at hotel
- In evening visit the Ganga Ceremony at Har ki Pauri.
- Stay overnight at Hardwar.

**Dt. 29/5/2024 HARIDWAR 🚗 BARKOT. (190 KMS / 7-8 HOURS)**

- Morning after breakfast, check out from hotel & drive for Barkot via Mussoorie.
- Visit Mussoorie way places like prakaseshwar mahadev & kempt fall.
- Evening visit Barkot village (by walk).
- Check in your hotel & overnight stay at Barkot.

**Dt. 30/5/2024 BARKOT 🚗 JANKICHATTI, YAMUNORI, JANKICHATTI, 🚗 BARKOT.  
(50 KMS DRIVE & 10 KMS TREK MORNING 5:00 AM TO RETURN 7-9 PM APPROX.)**

- Morning after breakfast drive for Jankichatti.
- Start your trek to Yamunotri (by walk, horse, pony or dolly on your expense).
- Visit Yamunotri temple & return trek to Jankichatti, Later drive towards the Barkot.
- Overnight stay at Barkot.

#### ABOUT YAMUNOTRI:

Yamunotri, the source of the Yamuna River and the seat of the goddess Yamuna, is one of the four sites in India's Char Dham pilgrimage. The temple of Yamunotri falls on the left bank and was originally constructed by Maharaj Pratap Shah of TehriGarhwal. Inside the temple, there is a statue of Goddess Yamuna imprinted in black stone that is mainly worshiped.



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**Dt. 31/5/2024 BARKOT 🚗 UTTARKASHI. (9 KMS / 4 5 HOURS)**

- Morning after breakfast, check out from hotel & Drive towards Uttarkashi.
- Visit the way places and reached at Uttarkashi.
- Check in your hotel & overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

**Dt. 01/6/2024 UTTARKASHI 🚗 GANGOTRI 🚗 UTTARKASHI. (200 KMS / 4 HOURS UP-4 HOURS DOWN)**

- Morning after breakfast Drive for Gangotri.
- Visit on the way places like TaptKund (Hot water sping) & Harshali village (Beautiful valley)
- Visit Gangotri temple & later drive back to Uttarkashi.
- Overnight stay at Uttarkashi.

#### ABOUT GANGOTRI:

Gangotri, the source of the river Ganges and seat of the goddess Ganga. The river is called Bhagirathi at the source and acquires the name Ganga from Devprayag onwards where it meets the Alaknanda. The origin of the holy river is at Gaumukh, which is an 18 km trek from Gangotri. Submerged in the holy river here is the self-manifested Shivalinga.

**Dt. 02/6/2024 UTTARKASHI 🚗 SITAPUR. (190 KMS / 7-8 HOURS)**

- Morning after breakfast, check out from Uttarkashi hotel & Drive for Sitapur/Guptkashi.
- Check in your hotel & overnight stay at Sitapur /Guptkashi.

**Dt. 03/6/2024 SITAPUR / 🚗 GAURIKUND (16 KMS TREK/8-9 HOURS) TO KEDARNATH.**

- Morning after breakfast, check out from hotel & Drive for Gaurikund.
- Visit the way places, start your trek (by walk, horse, pony or dolly on your expense)
- To Kedarnath. (Helicopter service is also available at extra cost).
- Visit Kedarnath temple, Darshan, Pooja.
- Overnight stay at Kedarnath.

#### ABOUT KEDARNATH:

Kedarnath hosts one of the holiest Hindu temples and is an ever most popular destination for Hindu pilgrims and tourists from all over the world in a scenic spot at the origin of the river Mandakani, the shrine of Kedarnath is most venerated amongst the Hindu pilgrims.

**Dt. 04/6/2024 KEDARNATH (16 KMS TREK/ 8-9 HOURS) TO GAURIKUND 🚗 SITAPUR.**

- Morning after breakfast checkout from hotel/ camp Kedarnath.
- Via visit from Kedarnath nath ghati and Himalaya view.
- Come back to Sitapur/ Guptkashi check in your hotel.
- Overnight stay at hotel Sitapur/ Guptkashi.





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**Dt. 05/6/2024 SITAPUR  PIPALKOTI**

- Morning after breakfast, checkout from hotel & start Drive for Pipalkoti.
- Start drive for Pipalkoti/Joshimath
- Check in hotel & Overnight stay at Pipalkoti

**Dt. 06/6/2024 PIPALKOTI  BADRINATH**

- Morning after breakfast, start drive through beautiful forest to Badrinath.
- Evening visit Badrinath Temple & return to Pipalkoti.
- Overnight stay at Badrinath.

**Dt. 07/6/2024 BADRINATH  RUDRPRAYAG.**

- Morning after breakfast, checkout from hotel & start Drive for Pipalkoti / Rudrprayag.
- Visit the way sight scenes and reached at Pipalkoti.
- Check in hotel & Overnight stay at Rudrprayag.

### ABOUT BADRINATH:

Badrinath is considered the holiest of the four important shrines. The town is at an altitude of 3,133 m. above sea level, situated on the left bank of river Alaknanda and exactly between the two mountains Nara and Narayan. The shrine is dedicated to Vishnu, the preserver and falls in the religious itinerary of every devout Hindu.

**Dt. 08/6/2024 RUDRAPRAYAG  HARIDWAR.**

- Morning after breakfast, checkout from hotel & start Drive towards Haridwar via Rishikesh.
- Visit the sight scenes like Ram jhula, Laxmanjhula, Geetabhavan etc. at Rishikesh
- Reached at Haridwar & Overnight stay at Haridwar.

**Dt. 09/6/2024 HARIDWAR  HARIDWAR**

- Morning after breakfast, check out from your hotel. At 11:30 am
- Drive towards Delhi Railway station/ bus stand.
- Dropping you at Railway station/ Bus stand.
- Here completed your memorable & beautiful journey of char dham with us.

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### **MANA VILLAGE:**

Mana village is the last village on the Indo – Tibetan border in the state of Uttarakhand. It is situated at a height of 3,219 meters, 4 km northwest from Badrinath. It is believed that the village was visited by Pandavas on their way to Heaven, after renouncing their kingdom.

### **Others:**

- § Insurance: Travel agency recommends that you insure yourself against sickness i.e. (Emergency rescue accident hospitalization) we are not liable and responsible for any damage.
- § About altitude sickness: it is an environmental condition during travel; you are suggested that during trekking please consult your doctor.
- § Photography: still camera, home video etc. are allowed in the Himalayas area, but not allowed inside the temple area.
- § Thirty percent (30%) of total amount of our program ticket charge per head will be deposited at the time of program booking and balance of total amount per head (full payment) will be deposited at the arrival time in Haridwar.
- § During program, if any change in the time of food arrangement/Hotel arrangement due to Traffic Jam, Road block, Mechanism failure in that situation you will have to compromise/ Co-operate with Travel Manager/ Travel Agent.
- § As mentioned above Char dharmyatra program will be 11 nights & 12 days in this program.
- § If there becomes delay in our fixed program due to natural causes i.e. (snow fall, rain, road lock etc.) in that situation you will have to pay extra service charge to travel agent or tour manager.



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### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS HELICOPTER:-**



- § There is very limited space for luggage in the helicopter. Only 5 kg luggage per passenger will be permitted. Passengers bringing excess baggage would not be allowed to take the same in the chopper. Passengers should carry only handbags as suitcases cannot be kept in the helicopter
- § Passengers weighing more than 80 Kgs have to pay Rs.350/Kg as overweight charges on spot and pax more than 120kg will have to take double ticket.

The cancellation of booking is possible subject to levy of following cancellation charges

- § Upto 15 days before journey — 75% of Booking amount
- § In case the journey is not finished within the stipulated time and passengers are not able to start the flying due to bad weather conditions or any technical reason than the liability of our company shall be limited to refund depends on at the time conditions.
- § In the case of a return ticket, if one leg of the journey is completed and the other leg is not completed either due to technical reasons or weather conditions, the passenger shall be entitled to refund of balance amount after one-way ticket cost. Amount will be refunded within next 14 working days after receiving refund request.

This will happen only in that condition when he won't want to visit accordingly our pre-planned program because we have to do some important payment before your arrival like Hotel reservation amount & vehicle rent etc. so you have to co-operate with us otherwise the agent & travel manager will not be responsible for any miss happening.

We give you a fixed itinerary before start the program and there is not any possibility to do change in it.

#### **SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT KEDARNATH:-**

When you go to visit Kedarnath after a night stay in any hotel of Guptkashi or Sitapur then you can enjoy the government stay on Kedarnath. This is a chargeable stay so all the charges of kedarnath stay only paid by you. Travel Company & agent don't do any booking for stay in kedarnath. Remember all this arrangement you have to do by own. When you return from kedarnath on next day travel agent do arrangement of your stay in Sitapur or Guptkashi.

**IT IS COMPOULSURY FOR EVERY PERSON ON TRIP TO HAVE HIS/HER ORIGINAL ID PROOF LIKE VOTER ID/ DRIVING LICENCE, AADHAR CARD ETC.**



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During your visit to Char Dham, you must follow the tips, things to do and things to avoid. It is not advisable to hurt the religious sentiments of people or disposing the waste in such remote and scenic locations.

**THE FOLLOWING YATRA TIPS WILL HELP TO MAKE YOUR CHAR DHAM YATRA COMFORTABLE, HASTLE FREE AND WILL KEEP YOU HEALTHY AND FIT DURING THE ENTIRE TRIP.**

- § The chardham or the four pilgrimage destinations are accessible only for six months (May to October) throughout the year. The region becomes inaccessible during the other half of the part of the year due to snowfall.
- § While visiting Hindu mythological sites, shrines and temples, one should remove shoes and cover head with a piece of cloth before entering the Holy Place.
- § Carry heavy woolen clothes to protect from cold weather during the month of October-November and carry moderate woolen during Summer Season.
- § Carry woolen Blanket, an umbrella, Raincoat, Torchlight, minimum luggage and canvas shoes with you. You can carry woolen sweater, monkey cap and muffler, which will enable you to with stand cold winds, at the upper level of Himalayas.
- § Do carry creams, moisturizers, sunscreen creams
- § Pack a medical kit with painkillers, antibiotics, cough lozenges, Antiseptic cream, Iodine, tube-squeeze cream and medicines for cold and fever.
- § Carry your routine medicines, as you might find only limited and general medicine at such remote locations.
- § Carry dark chocolates, dry fruits, Glucose (Glucon D), toffees. They will provide your instant energy during the trekking and during long jams.
- § When asking for directions, speak to shopkeepers, not pedestrians. Check with at least two persons or more.
- § Do not take pictures if cameras are not allowed in any particular area. Do not play with the sentiments of any particular religion.
- § At least a month before the Yatra, it is advisable to start preparatory exercises for the trip 4 months in advance.
- § Though self-managed tours happen to be economical, it is advisable for your Chardham yatra to go for a guided tour arranged by an expert local travel agent.
- § Carry extra batteries and films for your camera. As electricity is not regular in such places.
- § Do not travel in the rainy season as there are a lot of landslides during that time.
- § Book hotel rooms in advance if you are travelling close to the temple opening dates, there is a heavy rush of pilgrims. Check hotels on CharDham Route.
- § Alcohol or non-vegetarian food is not permitted during Char Dham Yatra Tour.
- § Drink packaged water or boiled water only.

## **CLOTHING DURING CHAR DHAM YATRA**

- § Summers (May, June, July, August)- Moderate Woolens
- § Winters (April, September, October, November) - Heavy Woolens

## **MEDICAL EMERGENCY NUMBER**

- § In case of any serious medical emergency, call 108 (The Mobile emergency service from Government of Uttarakhand). Don't make fake calls, as it is punishable offence.

## **TRAVELLING TIPS**

- § Train Connectivity: Rishikesh, Haridwar, Kotdwar and Dehradun are well connected to major cities of India by Railway Network. From here you can get bus or you can hire taxi as well.



- § Air Connectivity: Jolly Grant Airport, Dehradun. Helicopter service to Kedarnath and Badrinath is available from Delhi, Dehradun, Phata, Agustmuni and Gauchar near Rudraprayag and Jollygrant Airport Dehradun.

## **DRIVING TIPS IN UTTARAKHAND**

- § Always keep your vehicle on left side of the Road.
- § Use Horn at curves on hills, never overtake the overtaking vehicle.
- § One should not drive more than 8 hours a day in hilly region.
- § Avoid driving after sunset, as it is not allowed in hilly area of Uttarakhand.
- § Use shoes instead of slippers while driving.
- § Check your Brakes and Hand Brakes before starting journey.
- § Check the Headlights, Break light and Parking lights of your vehicle.
- § Always give way to uphill vehicles.
- § Keep your valid vehicle's documents with you to avoid inconvenience.
- § Before journey, make sure that fuel tank of your vehicle is full, in case of landslides you might have to take alternate long routes.
- § Ensure to refuel, where ever easily you get chance, during season there might be long queues in Petrol Pumps at main stations.
- § Carry first aid box with you.
- § Do not drink and drive.
- § In case of traffic jam, park your vehicle at the end of the queue. If you initiate a parallel queue, the traffic from other side might force you to drive in reverse gear, till you reach again at end of the original queue. And you may find it very difficult to drive long in reverse gear on a hilly road.
- § Do not compete with local vehicles/drivers. They know the terrain v



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
